

## Christmas Arrangements

There will be a Christmas Meal for parents and carers at The Lamb on The Strand on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> December, 7.45 for 8 pm. The cost is £15.95 for 1 course, £19.95 for 2 courses and £24.95 for 3 courses. The menu is on the Playgroup notice board. If you would like to come please order your meal and bring full payment by Mon 9<sup>th</sup> Dec. Cheques should be made payable to Seend Playgroup.

Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> December is our Nativity Morning. The children do a short Nativity Play and sing some Christmas songs.
